



## RMFSC MEMBERSHIP CLASSES

### Introductory 1 (\$50)

Introductory 1 is a one-year, non-renewable membership for skaters who have never been a member of a skating club and have not tested (USFS basic skills tests excepted). Members of this class may compete but may not test, apply for competitor funding or vote in general club elections. Skaters who are under 18 are not required to join with a parent/legal guardian, but parent/legal guardians may join as Supporting Members. Skaters in this class who are 18 years of age or older are eligible to serve on the board but may not hold office. This class includes USFS membership and a subscription to Skating Magazine. Members of this class are not expected to complete volunteer hours.

### Introductory 2 (\$75)

The Introductory 2 class is for skaters who have previously been a member of RMFSC, or another skating club, and have not tested (USFS basic skills tests excepted). Members of this class may compete as RMFSC members but may not test, apply for competitor funding or vote in general club elections. Skaters who are under 18 are not required to join with a parent/legal guardian, but parent/legal guardians may join as Supporting members. Skaters in this class who are 18 years of age or older are eligible to serve on the board of directors but may not hold office. This class includes USFS membership and a subscription to Skating Magazine. **Members of this class are asked to complete 6 volunteer hours each membership year. Families with multiple Introductory 2 skaters are asked to complete 9 volunteer hours each membership year.**

### Individual (\$110)

The Individual class is for skaters 18 years of age or older (as of July 1, 2019) and parents/legal guardians of minor skaters. *All minor skaters who compete and test must have a parent/legal guardian or skating sibling 18 years of age or older join at the Individual level.* Skating members of this class may compete, test and apply for competitor funding. All members of this class may vote in general elections, serve on the board and hold office. This class includes USFS membership and a subscription to Skating Magazine. **Members of this class are asked to complete 13 volunteer hours per Individual/family each membership year. Families with multiple skaters are asked to complete 19 volunteer hours per Individual/family each membership year. Please refer to the Volunteer Policy for more information.**

### Family (\$60)

The Family class is for skaters who are family members of anyone who maintains an Individual membership. Members of this class may compete, test and apply for competitor funding. All members of this class who are 18 years of age or older may vote in general elections, serve on the board and hold office. This class includes USFS membership. **Members of this class are asked to complete 13 volunteer hours per Individual/family each membership year. Families with multiple skaters are asked to complete 19 volunteer hours per Individual/family each membership year. Please refer to the Volunteer Policy for more information.**

**Collegiate (\$165)**

The Collegiate membership is a four-year, non-renewable membership for college-bound and college students. Members of this class may compete and test, but are not eligible for competitor funding, may not vote in general elections, and may not serve on the board. This class includes USFS membership and a subscription to Skating Magazine. Members of this class are not expected to complete volunteer hours.

**Recreational (\$85)**

The Recreational membership is for skaters 18 years of age or older. Members of this class may test, but may not compete and are not eligible for competitor funding. Members of this class may vote in general elections, serve on the board and hold office. This class includes USFS membership and a subscription to Skating Magazine. Members of this class are not expected to complete volunteer hours.

**Associate (\$85)**

The Associate membership is for members in good standing with another USFS member skating club who wish to participate in RMFSC activities. Members of this class may compete as members of their home club and test at RMFSC member rates, but are not eligible for competitor funding. Members of this class may not vote in general elections, serve on the board or hold office. USFS membership and Skating magazine subscription for this class is maintained through the member's home club. Members of this class are not expected to complete volunteer hours.

**Supporting (\$30)**

The Supporting membership is for non-skaters who wish to participate in RMFSC activities. Supporting members may not compete, test, or apply for competitor funding. Members of this class who are 18 years of age or older may vote in general elections, serve on the board and hold office. This class includes USFS membership if the supporting member qualifies as a "subsequent family member" under USFS rules. Members of this class are not expected to complete volunteer hours.

**Coach**

The Coach membership is for coaches who (i) conduct at least 60% of their private coaching activities at RMFSC's home rink, (ii) do not maintain a home club membership with another USFS member skating club, and (iii) are registered, background checked and CER compliant in accordance with USFS requirements. Coach membership is not available to coaches who only teach Learn-to-Skate. Coach members may not compete, test or apply for competitor funding. Members of this class who are 18 years of age or older may vote in general elections and serve on the board as a coach representative, but may not hold office. This class includes USFS membership and a subscription to Skating Magazine. Members of this class are not expected to complete volunteer hours.

**Official**

The Official membership is for USFS qualified officials who do not maintain a home club membership in another USFS member skating club. Official members may not compete, test or apply for competitor funding. Members of this class may serve on the board as an official representative, but may not vote or hold office. This class includes USFS membership and a subscription to Skating Magazine. Members of this class are not expected to complete volunteer hours.
