



2020-2021 RMFSC MEMBERSHIP

Skaters, Parents, Coaches, Officials and Friends:

It is now time to join RMFSC or renew your RMFSC membership for the 2020-2021 skating season. The new membership year begins July 1, 2020 and ends June 30, 2021.

How to Join/Renew

Membership renewals are administered via EntryEeze.com. To access your account, go to EntryEeze.com and click on the "Find your home club" button. Type in "Rocky Mountain Figure Skating Club" and click on the "Go to club" button. Click on the "Access my account" button. Login with your email and password. If you are a new or transferring member, click on the "Apply for membership" button and set up an account. Once you have logged on, click on the "Apply/Renew" button and follow the instructions. If you wish to apply/renew via a paper packet, please contact membership@rmfsc.org.

Payment

RMFSC prefers online payment via EntryEeze.com (simply "check-out" after completing the on-line application). We accept Visa, Mastercard and Discover. Credit card processing fees will be assessed. If you are unable to pay online, please contact membership@rmfsc.org.

Membership Categories Overview

RMFSC maintains many membership classes to serve the various needs of skaters. The **Introductory 1 and 2** classes are offered at a low cost to allow skaters to compete at the basic skills/free skate level. When competitive skaters are ready to take their pre-preliminary test, they must join with a parent/legal guardian (or a skating sibling who is 18 or older) at the **Individual/Family** level. Adult skaters who do not wish to compete but want to test may join at the **Recreational** level. College bound skaters may choose a 4-year **Collegiate** membership. Skaters who train at the Ice Centre but who are members of other clubs, may join as **Associate** members. Skating enthusiasts who do not skate may join as a **Supporting** member. **Coach** and **Official** memberships also are available. *Please refer to the detailed descriptions of membership classes posted on RMFSC.org for list of privileges and responsibilities associated with each.*

Volunteer Expectations

RMFSC is a volunteer run club and expects Introductory 2 and Individual/Family members to contribute volunteer hours each year. Introductory 2 members are asked to complete 6 hours (9 if multiple skaters in family) and Individual/Family members are asked to complete 13 hours (19 if multiple skaters in family). You will be required to sign up for at least one area of interest when you join/renew. You will be contacted during the membership year regarding volunteer opportunities in your area of interest. Also, please frequently check the volunteer SignUp on RMFSC.org for volunteer opportunities. Members must record their volunteer hours in their EntryEeze account. In contrast to previous years, members will not be assessed a monetary fine for failing to complete their hours. This change in policy is intended to encourage positive participation in RMFSC.

RMFSC Required Agreements Overview

When you join or renew, you must sign several agreements on behalf of yourself and your skater. Those agreements are as follows: (i) Waiver and Release of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement; (ii) Parental Consent and Indemnification Agreement; (iii) Consent for Medical Attention or Treatment; (iv) Member Code of Conduct and Ethics, and (v) RMFSC Volunteer Policy and Agreement. Please review these agreements carefully.
